Autism Waiver Community Meetings

Please join us for a community meeting to learn about the upcoming Autism Waiver program. This program is a Medicaid Waiver program designed to provide intensive home-based intervention for young children with autism. Due to the foresight and generosity of the members of the Arkansas General Assembly, these services will be provided to a group of Arkansas' youngest citizens with autism through funds provided by the Tobacco Tax enacted in the 87th General Assembly.

While exact details are pending approval by the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services (CMS), the program is expected to roll out the first part of the year and target children with autism between the ages of 18 months and 7 years.

These meetings are for parents, provider agencies, and individuals experienced with children with autism who may be interested in participating in this program.
